Four Gifts Jesus Gave Us!

Freedom from shame! Col 2.13,14 And you, being dead in your sins and unregenerated, has He reanimated now together with Him, *having forgiven you all trespasses by blotting out the handwriting of laws standing against you*, which was contrary to you, and He took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross...

God made Jesus to be sin for us, who personally knew no sin; that we might be made *the righteousness of God in Him*. **2C5.21**

So put on the new man, which after God is created *in righteousness and true holiness*. **E4.24**

Revelation 1.5,6 Unto Him that loved us, *and washed us from our sins in His own blood, And has made us kings and priests unto God and His Father*; to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus!

Healing from pain! Acts 10.38 God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him! *Before the Cross God made His will known for our healing... "I will..."*

Isaiah 53.4,5 He bears our sins, for us He is pained and we accounted Him to be in trouble with God... but it was for our sins that He was tormented, beaten and bruised... the beatings of our wholeness were given to Him *and with those bruises we were healed!*

After the Cross... Healing became the children's bread, and we should be loosed from all sickness and disease!

The breaking of chains! Romans 6.16-17 Don't you know that to whom you stand with as a slave, his slave you are and it's who you are to obey; whether it's sin unto death, or to obedience unto righteousness? *But thank God that though you were the slaves of sin, you have now obeyed from the heart that doctrine which was delivered to you to deliver you...*

Romans 6.18,19 *Being then made free from sin, you became the slaves of righteousness* (I speak in human terms because of the dulling effects of your flesh): so as you once devoted yourselves as slaves to uncleanness and to one sin after another; *even so now you are under obligation, as slaves justified by Christ, to the process of purification...*

Romans 6.20-22 For when you were the slaves of sin, you were free from righteousness (I ask, what fruit did you have in those things that you are now ashamed of? For the end of those things was death); *But now being freed from sin, and becoming the slaves of God, you have the fruit of holiness, and at the end everlasting life.*

Nothing from the past— no person, event, habit – has the power to keep you from God's plans for your future!

Taking His name! *And the disciples were first called Christ-resemblers (Christians) in Antioch! Acts 11.26*

Romans 8.14-16 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, *they are the sons of God*. For you have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; *but you have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father*. The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit, *that we are the children of God!*

Philippians 2.10-15 Knowing we will bow before Jesus, walk out your salvation w/fear and trembling; for God is at work in you to do His will and good pleasure. Do it w/o complaining and resistance, *that you may become blameless and harmless children of God w/o fault in the midst of a warped and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world!*

God is faithful, by whom you were called *unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord*.

1C1.9

If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, *we have fellowship one with another*, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. **1J1.7**
